Want to read some passages in A Course in Miracles?

Here are some quotes from **A Course in Miracles** that touch on the subject of this lesson. You can read the section of the Course in which they appear. (Do keep in mind that it may be challenging to read these sections without reading the sections that come before them. **A Course in Miracles** is written in such a way that the concepts build upon each other as you go along.) Remember T is for the Text, W is for the workbook, and M is for the Teacher's Manual. The text, workbook, and teacher's manual are all in one book. (They used to be 3 separate books) In case you have different editions of the book, when I use a quote from the Text, I will also reference what chapter and section the quote appears in.

- "Your present trust in Him is the defense that promises a future undisturbed, without a trace of sorrow, and with joy that constantly increases, as this life becomes a holy instant." P. 255 (W) Lesson 135
- "Future loss is not your fear. But present joining is your dread. Who can feel desolation except now? A future cause as yet has no effects. And therefore must it be that if you fear, there is a present cause. And it is this that needs correction, not a future state." P. 559 (T) Chapter 26, Section VIII
- "In Him you have no cares and no concerns, no burdens, no anxiety, no pain, no fear of future and no past regrets. In timelessness you rest, while time goes by without its touch upon you, for your rest can never change in any way at all....Let these periods of rest and respite reassure your mind that all its frantic fantasies were but the dreams of fever that has passed away." P. 197 (W) Lesson109
- "Try to remember when there was a time—perhaps a minute, maybe even less—when nothing came to interrupt your peace; when you were certain you were loved and safe. Then try to picture what it would be like to have that moment be extended to the end of time and to eternity. Then let the sense of quiet that you felt be multiplied another hundred more. And now you have a hint, not more than just the faintest intimation of the state your mind will rest in when the truth has come." P. 107 (W) Lesson 107
