Want to read some passages in *A Course in Miracles*?

Here are some quotes from ***A Course in Miracles*** that touch on the subject of this lesson. You can read the section of the Course in which they appear. (Do keep in mind that it may be challenging to read these sections without reading the sections that come before them.

A Course in Miracles is written in such a way that the concepts build upon each other as you go along.) Remember T is for the Text, W is for the workbook, and M is for the Teacher's Manual. The text, workbook, and teacher's manual are all in one book. (They used to be 3 separate books.) In case you have different editions of the book, when I use a quote from the Text, I will also reference what chapter and section the quote appears in.

- "Teach only love for that is what you are....only by teaching it can you learn it. As you teach, so will you learn." p.99(T) Chapter 6, Section III
- "It is not up to you to change your brother, but merely to accept him as he is. Any attempt you make to correct a brother means that you believe correction by you is possible and this can only be the arrogance of the ego." p.167 (T) Chapter 9, Section III
- "Who could be set free while he imprisons anyone? A jailer is not free, for he is bound together with his prisoner. He must be sure that he does not escape, and so he spends his time in keeping watch on him. The bars that limit him become the world in which his jailer lives, along with him. And it is on his freedom that the way to liberty depends for both of them. Therefore, hold no one prisoner. Release instead of bind, for thus are you made free." p.366 (W) Workbook Lesson 192
- "The only safety lies in extending the Holy Spirit, because as you see His gentleness in others your own mind perceives itself as totally harmless. Once it can accept this fully, it sees no need to protect itself. The protection of God then dawns upon it, assuring it that it is perfectly safe forever. " p.100(T) Chapter 6, Section III
